# Find the Right Networking Job

- In your job search, you should include these steps:
- Evaluate your skills and strengths.
- Research the types of jobs available that require your strengths.
- Create your resume.
- Send your resume to potential employers and post it with online job search websites.
- Talk with people who work in the type of job you are interested in.
- Talk with people who work for companies that you find desirable.
- Apply and interview for available jobs.

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- Imagine that you have submitted your resume to a company and that they have asked you for an interview.
- Question Types
- Expect your interviewer to ask many different types of questions, for example:
- Behavioral - How you interact with people and the workplace culture: "Are you available to work longer hours when needed?"

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- Hypothetical - How you would handle a particular situation: "What would you do if the building lost power?"
- Leading - A series of questions directed to a specific type of situation: "Have you ever worked in a lab setting?"
- Open-ended - A short question requiring an extended response: "Tell me about your job experience."

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- Interview Methods
- Many different methods are used for interviews. Common methods include:
  - A screening interview over the telephone
  - An interview at a career fair
  - An interview with one or more people at the hiring company site
  - An informational interview is one where you talk with someone at a particular company. You learn about the company and the interviewer learns about you.
